POSTION: Medical Radiation Technologist/ X-Ray Technologist, Temporary Full-time, 17 to 22 months

3. To participate in professional development activities (assigned or voluntary) aimed at maintaining or improving knowledge and skills to meet the changing requirement of patient care.
4. To participate in standby and on-call rotation for evenings and weekends ensuring no gaps in service. Short notice coverage may be required, on occasion.
