Registered Nursing Student – Tuition Bursary Program

Summary:

The Red Lake Margaret Cochenour Hospital Foundation has partnered with the RLMCM Hospital to offer bursary opportunities to support recruitment in departments that demonstrate chronic hiring needs. The RN Nursing Student Bursary Program works as follows:

- In return for a minimum two-year commitment to provide professional nursing services to the Red Lake Hospital, the Red Lake Margaret Cochenour Hospital Foundation shall offer an **incentive of \$15,000 for students currently enrolled in an accredited Registered Nursing Program.**
- Successful candidates will be eligible to receive 50% (\$7500) of these funds at the end of their third year of study.
- The remaining 50% (\$7500) will be issued upon commencing employment with the Red Lake Hospital, as a Registered Nurse.
- This tuition bursary program is a private endeavor of the Red Lake Margaret Cochenour Hospital Foundation and may be used in addition to / conjunction with other government provided incentives.
- If a successful candidate leaves prior to the end of the two-year service period, repayment of the bursary is required on a pro-rated basis. A payback stipulation will be incorporated into all contracts.

Qualifications:

- Applicants must have completed at least two years of an accredited Registered Nursing Program. Program enrollment must be on a full-time basis.
- Applicants must be eligible to apply for licensure with the College of Nurses of Ontario as a Registered Nurse, upon graduation.
- Applicants must be available to begin full-time work, upon graduation from the Nursing Program.
- Selected candidates will be required to participate in a formal interview, as well as provide references and a clean Vulnerable Sector Check in order to determine suitability for the program.
