Fun in Red Lake is not limited to the summer months. Enjoy ice fishing, cross-country skiing, snow shoeing, snowmobiling, and much more!

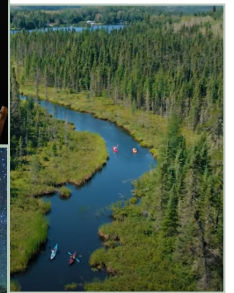

The sight of a star-filled sky and dancing **northern lights** on a crisp winter's night.



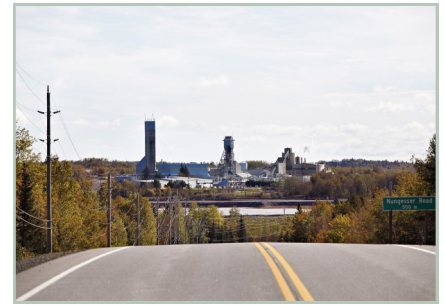

one from 1825 to 1925 at Post Narrows, and
one from 1925 to 1933 at Johnson's Point.
